

On November 30th 2020 work began on the contract for the new school. In the 2-year period since that day, it has been amazing to watch our new school take shape. It was a joyful day when we made the transition to this fantastic new building on 9th November 2022. The pictures above show the progression of the building on the anniversary of the contract commencement date. Work has started on the demolition of the old school building. Once the demolition is completed the final part of the project will be to provide 3 new ball courts (yard), additional bicycle parking, pedestrian access and the main staff car park.
