Mobile Phone Policy (Pupils)

Smart phones are banned from the school. Non-internet enabled phones are permitted provided strict conditions are adhered to. The conditions are available below and on the school website. Permission slips are available from the office and must be submitted to the class teacher who will maintain a record of children with permission. New permission slips must be provided for each new school year.

- Parents must grant permission for their son to carry a mobile phone. Permission slips are available from the office and must be returned to the class teacher
- Where a parent grants their son permission to have a mobile phone, it must remain switched off and concealed in the school bag throughout the course of the day
- Under no circumstances are mobile phones permitted on the school yard
- A pupil may switch on a phone after school for the purpose of communication only. Phones must not be used for playing games or displaying/taking images or video
- Any breach of the above guidelines will result in the confiscation of the phone, which must be collected from the school by the parent/guardian
- The school will take no responsibility for any phone which is lost, damaged or stolen from a pupil while on the school premises

Using a phone to take photos or video of other pupils or staff members is strictly forbidden. Such activity will be deemed to be a breach of the school's Code of Behaviour.
